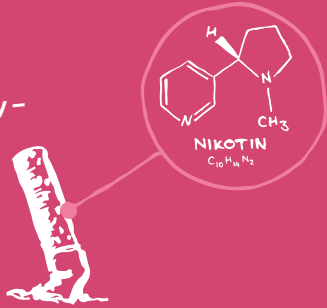


CIGARETTE BUTTS. An enormous dimension.

TAKE-AWAY CUPS. A dangerous trend.

Take-away cups are a dead end for the environment. It doesn't make any difference whether it's a plastic or paper cup, because the latter also contains plastic. In Bremen alone, we produce a mountain of 23 million cups every single year. They waste resources when produced, only to be recycled in a complex manner, at best.

Knowledge is all important in our fight for a clean environment. It is fairly obvious that we have to change something, because there is more to bin: 20m³ waste is collected by the Bremer Stadtreinigung (Bremen city department of cleaning) in our streets on every single day, even though one of the 3.600 available bins is sometimes only 50m away. It is so easy to go "all in for Bremen". Be there for a clean city!

WHY IS WASTE (Y)OUR SUBJECT?

Many types of waste contain raw materials. As garbage, these resources are not only worthless, but sometimes downright dangerous – for you and for the environment. Put into the (correct) bin, though, they become "valuable". Apart from that, a city without cigarette butts, chewing gum etc. looks a lot better. Our most important partner in the fight against the amount of waste in the streets and parks of Bremen? This is you!



- You make the few steps and take your waste to the nearest bin
- You put the poop of your four-legged companion into the appropriate container
- You decide against non-returnable packaging
- You clean up after a party in the park
- You avoid litter(ing)

You can make a difference!

CHEWING GUM. A treacherous indulgence.

If it is simply spat out, a chewing gum needs 5 years to decompose. In the meantime, it's ugly and a danger to the native wildlife. Once swallowed, it can lead to a deadly obstruction of the bowels.

Therefore be good to the environment:
Off with the mobile tooth care
into the nearest bin.



DOG EXCREMENT. A serious germ.

With 16.000 dogs in Bremen, the 'poop' quickly turns meadows and waysides into cesspits full of the danger of infection. What some may consider as manure ends up on the soles of pedestrians all over the city. And with it also the the parasites existing therein a danger for other domestic animals, for small children, and adults with immune deficiency.

There is only one solution:
take a bag along, pick up the poop, and depose of it in the nearest poop-bin.



PLASTIC. A problematic material with consequences.

Every year, approximately 13 million tons of plastic end up in our oceans. Many of these result from – often unnecessary – packaging. But exactly this waste is avoidable.



Make use of reusable packaging like nets for fruit and vegetables, hessian bags and reusable bottles, and buy only loose, unpacked goods, whenever possible.
At home, plastics go into the Yellow Bin, outside always into the nearest bin

LITTERING. A crime against the environment.

With littering, a little quickly grows into a rubbish tip. This is not only an ugly sight. Often, the rubbish discharges harmful substances into the environment.
